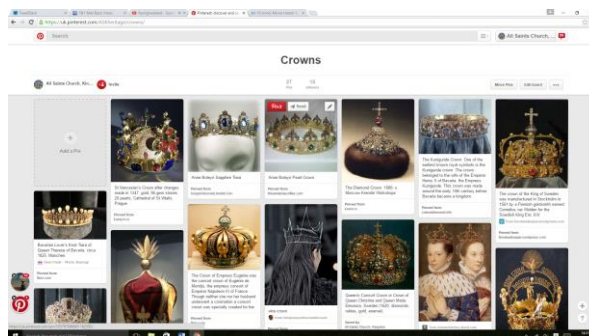
Volunteers Needed!
