

The Parish Church of All Saints

5 August 2018 - 10th Sunday after Trinity

You are very welcome to All Saints this morning for this Eucharist (Holy Communion). Children are very welcome here and, if they want to, they can take part in the children's activities that happen at the east end of the church and in the choir vestry.

Children leave after the first hymn and return for the Communion.

Today we sing the **mass setting**, number **541** in the hymn book, **starting at the Gloria**.

The service starts on page 1 of the green booklet.

The Opening Hymn is **397**.

We sing the Gloria (the words are on page 17).

We say together the collect – the special prayer for this Sunday.

Let your merciful ears, O Lord, be open to the prayers of your humble servants; and that they may obtain their petitions make them to ask such things as shall please you; through Jesus Christ your Son our Lord, who is alive and reigns with you, in the unity of the Holy Spirit, one God, now and for ever. Amen

The reading from the Old Testament today is **Exodus 16:2-4, 9-15**.

We stand for the Cantor to lead us in singing from **Psalm 145** (number **540** in the hymn book). The congregational refrain is:



The New Testament reading today is **Ephesians 4:1-16**.

The **Gradual Hymn** is **333** after which we remain standing and turn to face the centre of the church from where the Gospel is read.

Today's Gospel is **John 6:24-35** – the text is on the back of this pew sheet.

The preacher today is the **Rev'd David Bell**.

After the Peace we sing the **Offertory Hymn 280** during which a collection is taken for the work of the church, and the bread and wine for the Eucharist are brought to the altar.

The service continues with the Preparation of the Table on page 7 of the green booklet.

This morning we will use **Eucharistic Prayer A**.

After Communion the Priest will say:

God of our pilgrimage,
you have willed that the gate of mercy
should stand open for those who trust in you:
look upon us with your favour
that we who follow the path of your will
may never wander from the way of life;
through Jesus Christ our Lord.
Amen

The **Final Hymn** is **384**.

After the service, refreshments are served. Please feel very welcome to stay and enjoy, and if you have not been to the church before, please do introduce yourself to one of the clergy or churchwardens - we'd love to meet you.
