What is the Seven Saxon King Embroidery project?

Seven Saxon kings, including the first 'Kings of England' are thought to have been crowned at Kingston Upon Thames. This significant heritage story is told through seven spectacular embroidery panels depicting the Kings with rich imagery based on events from their reigns.

So far, we have raised enough money to commission four of the seven embroideries. Athelstan was installed in 2020. Edmund, Eadred and Edwy will be joining him in the near future.

We now need to raise £75,000 to commission the last three kings (Edward the Elder, Edward the Martyr and Ethelred the Unready).

Professional book binders, Wyvern bindery will complete the book in a high standard.




About the Book of Names
